- **Required General Education Core** (15 credit hours minimum) including ENG 111; a mathematics course or sequence of courses approved for the mathematics component of the College's General Education Core; and at least 9 hours in two the following categories: arts and humanities electives, social and behavioral sciences electives, and natural science electives.
- **Concentrations/Areas of Study** (30 credit hours minimum) which is formed according to one of the following models: a) an interdisciplinary, but coherent combination of courses drawn from a minimum of two and a maximum of four instructional areas; b) up to forty semester credit hours awarded by the institution for documentable educational experiences or courses completed at other institutions of higher education or educational enterprises judged by the institution to be of college level; or c) an unusual by academically coherent combination of technical and general studies courses.
- **AIS Related Electives** (15 credit hours minimum) a combination of technical and/or general courses totaling a minimum of fifteen semester credit hours planned in consultation with an academic advisor which supplement the individualized area of concentration.

Required General Education Core (15 credit hours minimum) including ENG 111; a mathematics course or sequence of courses approved for the mathematics component of the College's General Education Core; and at least 9 hours in two the following categories: arts and humanities electives, social and behavioral sciences electives, and natural science electives.
